

Day 1: Friday, October 13, 2023 Boston,


Massachusetts - Tour Begins Get ready for a *wicked* good time from Boston all the way to the Cape! First up is the city steeped in history and bursting with character: Boston welcomes you with its cobblestone streets, stately brownstone buildings, distinct neighborhoods, museums, shopping, and more.

Day 2: Saturday, October 14, 2023 Boston Take in Boston this morning on a panoramic city tour. You'll see historic sites like the Old South Meeting House, Boston Common, and the quaint cobblestone streets and federal-style rowhouses of Beacon Hill. Your tour ends in Faneuil Hall, where you'll have free time to explore and try a local lunch favorite, like "clam chowdah". Faneuil Hall – or Quincy Market – has been a marketplace and meeting hall since 1743; it truly is the heart of Boston. Later this afternoon, join a local foodie for a tour of Boston's famed North End. Enjoy some local bites along the way culminating with dinner at a local restaurant with your fellow travelers – toast to new friends met in the old city of Boston. (B, D)

Day 3: Sunday, October 15, 2023 Boston - Salem - Boston Today, head to the North Shore of Massachusetts to the city of Salem. When you arrive, **it's your choice!** Choose to either venture through Salem on a historical tour, discovering how the dangerous but profitable maritime trade built not only mansions, but Salem's rich culture **-OR-** visit the sites of the darkest time in Salem's long history, the Salem Witch Trials, where neighbor turned on neighbor in a frenzy of suspicion. Afterwards, take a stroll down the cobblestones of Essex Street for the quirky shops and great dining, or just relax and admire views of the harbor. Perhaps you'll decide to tour the House of the Seven Gables, made famous by Nathaniel Hawthorne. (B)

Day 4: Monday, October 16, 2023 Boston - Plymouth - Cape Cod This morning, venture to the home of the first permanent colonial settlement in the country: Plymouth and see where the Pilgrims disembarked the Mayflower in 1620: Plymouth Rock. Enjoy an included visit on the Mayflower II,* a full-scale replica of the 17th century ship. Later, arrive at your beachfront hotel for a 4-night stay on the Cape. (B)

Day 5: Tuesday, October 17, 2023 Cape Cod - Provincetown Travel to Provincetown, located on the tip of the Cape. This lively artist colony remains famous for its crafts and bright seagoing flair. Take advantage of some free time to explore the many shops and grab a bite for lunch in town. Then climb aboard an SUV to ride through the iconic sand dunes of the Cape! It's a scenic adventure with spectacular views of this ecosystem. Tonight, sit down for a lobster feast – a quintessential New England experience. (B, D)

Day 6: Wednesday, October 18, 2023 Cape Cod - Sandwich - Cape Cod Take in Cape Cod your way because today, **it's your choice!** Take advantage of the amenities at your waterfront hotel, perhaps sitting by the pool or visiting the private beach on the resort's property - **OR-** join your Tour Manager for a trip to Sandwich. In Sandwich, you can get a peek into the glassblowing art form with a demonstration at the Sandwich Glass Museum **-OR-** visit the Heritage Museums & Gardens celebrating the culture and history of the region with 100 acres of gardens and exhibits including classic cars and a working carousel from 1908. The remainder of your day and evening is at leisure. (B)

Day 7: Thursday, October 19, 2023 Cape Cod - Nantucket - Cape Cod Set off via ferry to explore the

idyllic island of Nantucket. From its cobblestone Main Street to its beaches and lighthouses, this place lives up to its reputation. During time at leisure, meander the waterfront where sailboats and yachts sway in the harbor or shop for a famous Nantucket basket. Visit the Nantucket Whaling Museum and learn about this island's history as the former whaling capital of the world and even see the skeleton of a 46-foot-long whale. Tonight, enjoy a farewell dinner at a popular local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 8: Friday, October 20, 2023 Cape Cod - Tour Ends Your tour comes to a close today, leaving you with many fond memories. (B)

Experience It! Provincetown's National Seashore Park Dunes

The sand dunes of the Province Lands found at the Cape's tip are part of the protected Cape Cod National Seashore. These rolling windswept sand hills are a vital habitat to wildlife and iconic feature of the Cape Cod landscape. Hidden away here are the dune shacks of Peaked Hill Bars Historic District, a preserved historical landmark where artists and writers have long found solitude and inspiration.

IDENTIFICATION

Travel within USA

For travel completed by May 2, 2023, all airlines will ask for identification when you check in. It is recommended that you carry a passport if you have one. A driver's license (with a photo I.D.) is also acceptable for domestic flights.

Effective for travel May 3, 2023 forward, the REAL ID Act standards for identification while travelling will be in effect. This means a standard issued driver's license used as a form of identification will no longer be accepted for domestic air travel within the United States.

Instead, a Real ID compliant form of identification must be presented both at the time of booking air travel with Collette and upon checking in at the airport to board any flight. Any fees associated with changing a reservation resulting from a non-compliant identification will be the responsibility of the guest. To complete your tour, we include roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel.
